

The Disciple's Prayer Model

Matthew 6:9-13 (CSB)

“Our Father in heaven, Your name be honored as holy...”

Praise: Worship and Adore Him.

Picture Calvary and thank God that you can call Him “Father” by virtue of the blood of Jesus.

- Praise God for Who He is and for what He has done for us.
- For Forgiveness of Sin – He is our Righteousness
- For the Gift of the Holy Spirit – He is our Peace, our Comforter
- For our Health and Healing – He is our Healer
- For our Freedom from Worry – He is our Provider
- For our Freedom from Death and Hell – He is our Salvation
- For the Care of Daily Life – He is our Shepherd

“...Your Kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in Heaven...”

Purpose: God's will be done.

- Pray for yourself, and your family members.
- Pray for our Pastor, his family, his protection and his work.
- Pray for our lead team, their families and for Godly leadership.
- Pray for our ministry and support staff, as well as their families.
- Pray for the Harvest of Souls.
- Pray for men and women everywhere to be disciples of Jesus.
- Pray for our nation, our political leaders.
- Pray for our church family to be a mighty force for the work of the Lord in Sumner County, Tennessee, the US, and around the World. (Acts 1:8)
- Ask God for us to realize His blessings in our Life, Family, Church, Church Staff, Government Leaders

“...Give us today our daily bread...”

Provision: Trust God to meet your needs. Claim His promises.

- Philippians 4:19

“...And forgive us our debts as we also have forgiven our debtors...”

Pardon: Claim cleansing and forgiveness.

Acknowledge sin: If we confess our sins, he is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. – 1 John 1:9

Forsake sin: The one who conceals his sin will not prosper, but whoever confesses and renounces them will find mercy. – Proverbs 28:13

Release others from sin: For if you forgive others their offenses, your heavenly Father will forgive you as well. But if you don't forgive others, your Father will not forgive your offenses. – Matt. 6:14-15

“...And do not bring us into temptation but deliver us from the evil one...”

Protection: Thank God for victory over the enemy.

Put on the full armor of God so that you can stand against the schemes of the devil. – Eph. 6:11-18

1. Loins girded about with TRUTH
2. Breastplate of RIGHTEOUSNESS
3. Feet shod with the READINESS OF THE GOSPEL OF PEACE
4. Shield of FAITH
5. Helmet of SALVATION
6. Sword of the Spirit, which is the WORD OF GOD

Be sober-minded, be alert. Your adversary the devil is prowling around like a roaring lion, looking for anyone he can devour. Resist him, firm in the faith, knowing that the same kind of sufferings are being experienced by your fellow believers throughout the world. The God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, will himself, restore, establish, strengthen, and support you after you have suffered a little while. – 1 Peter 5:8-10

Therefore, submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. – James 4:7

You are from God, little children, and you have conquered them, because the one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world. – 1 John 4:4
